What is a 50/20?

Walk 50 miles covered in 20 hours. This is an endurance event, not a race.

*Who can Participate?

Scouts & Young Women ages 12 and up. Adults, Leaders, Families

Cub Scouts may complete the 1st 25 miles if accompanied by an adult. (Adults accompanying Cubs do not need to register unless completing the full 50 miles)

Cost is \$15 per person. Additional late registration fee of \$10 starting September 1st.

How does participating in the 50/20 benefit my youth?

Former General YM President Larry Gibson spoke in General Conference on the value of this 50/20 event, and what it did for him personally and his own boys.

1. Build confidence and determination as our youth prove to themselves that they can 'DO HARD THINGS'
2. Build stronger relationships in their families and quorums
3. Help our youth follow the example of the Savior in courage, determination, and finishing

What is the course of the 50 mile event

- Start and finish at Utah Lake State Park, Provo River Trailhead.
- Walk the trail to the mouth of Provo Canyon, then head west to connect to the Murdock Canal Trail, then almost over to Alpine highway, returning back the same way.

When does this start and end?

- Start on Friday Sept. 14th between 3 – 6:30pm.
- End on Saturday Sept 15th when the course is completed – likely mid-morning through mid-afternoon.

**Does everyone get a T-shirt?

Everyone that registers before Sept. 1st is guaranteed a T-Shirt. We will do our best to accurately estimate the number of late registrations, but cannot guarantee late registrants will get a shirt.

What is the award for Completing the event within 20 hours?

Everyone completing the event within 20 hours receives a quality key chain with the 50/20 logo (above). Cubs completing the 25 miles will also receive the award.

What support is available along the course?

We will have staffed aid/rest stations about every mile or so for the entire course. We will have professional medical personnel, water, and restrooms along the course.
