

Cub Scout Day Camp

Dates – June 4, 5, 6, 7, 2019

Tue. June 4 = Ephraim Stake, Fillmore Stake
Wed. June 5 = Mt. Pleasant Stake, Manti Stake
Thur. June 6 = Gunnison Stake, Moroni Stake
Fri. June 7 = Salina Stake, Mt. Pleasant North Stake

Who Attends Day Camp-

All registered Cub Scouts (Wolf, Bears, Webelos)
plus 7 yr. old boys turning 8 in June, July or August.

Place- Gunnison City Park & Swimming Pool (300 North, Main)

Time- 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. arrive as close to 8:00 a.m. as possible

Cost- \$11.00 for each Cub Scout, Webelos Scout, Den Chief. This price includes Swimming, Crafts, BB Guns, Archery, Treats, Games, activities. It does NOT include a T-Shirt, nor shopping @ the Trading Post. Leaders don't have to pay, therefore they will not do the activities or get the treats. However, if adults want to swim, it will cost them \$2.00.

T-Shirt- each Pack will arrange for their own T-Shirts. Staff T-Shirts are being printed by Gryffyn in Ephraim; phone 283-5745; located North of Dollar Tree. They'll do (one color print) youth sizes for \$5.00 each. You can use our design for no extra charge or they'll do your design for a reasonable set-up fee. Or you can decide what design & where to get them.

Date Day Camp Registration is Due- No Later than March 31, 2019 Register your pack for Camp, all at the same time by going to the District's Web Site @ utahscouts.org/arapeen. When finished, print off the receipt showing payment. Bring receipt to Camp along with a completed **Roster and Health Forms**.

Health Forms- Every person (leaders, drivers, everyone) attending Day Camp **MUST** have a Health Form (which does not have to be turned in until at camp). If a boy is leaving Camp early, a signed note stating details must be turned in at time of registration.

Leadership- Two-Deep Leadership is required. Leaders must spend the entire day at Camp and be prepared to help where needed. **Do Not** bring young children or babies with you to Camp! Bring your lunch.

Transportation- Do not transport boys in the back of trucks or campers. Seat Belts are required for all passengers. You can park on the North side of the Swimming Pool, or street side around the park.

BSA Registration- All boys must be registered with BSA (which is now done only on-line). 7 yr. olds turning 8 in June, July or August can attend Camp this year. Sign them up just like the other boys when you register your Pack for Day Camp on-line. Then make sure all boys are registered with BSA by Camp.

Lunch- everyone will need their own lunch, & a way to keep it cold. Also, bring a small filled water bottle.

Trading Post- There will be a Trading Post. Candy, pop, and small toy items, etc. will cost \$1.00 – \$2.00. A few items (like rabbit furs & spinners) will cost \$5. & \$6. This year there will be a Hawaiian Ice-Cream-Slushy Booth that costs more than the regular sno-cones.

Bring- Completed Roster & Health Forms; receipt of payment. **Lunches, Swim Suit & Towel**, water bottle.

Inclement Weather- Day Camp is an all-day-out-side activity. Come prepared with coats, umbrella, etc. If the weather gets really, really bad we'll move inside.
