



High Uintah Scout Camp-Vernal, Utah

Program:

High Uintah is a unique wilderness-based high mountain camp near Vernal, Utah that is located adjacent to the High Uintah Wilderness Area and partners with the Ashley National Park Forest Service at Windy Park.

Field Sports — Shooting programs, archery and rifle are offered at camp.

Aquatics — The camp offers canoeing and rowing, along with kayaking, small boat sailing, and fishing provided by the DNR. The camp offers a polar bear dip (BRRRR)

Merit Badges—Merit badges and activities are offered in handicraft, Scout craft, ecology, field sports, and aquatics

Mountain Man—This is a chance to remember the way the West once was. There will be mountain man games including tomahawk throw, black powder shoot, atlatl throw, as well as, Rendezvous trading

Hiking—Hiking programs such as the cat eye trail, honor trail, and advancement hike are offered in this beautiful, pristine area

Carter Trail Run—Scouts assemble at the amphitheater, where they are divided into groups for various competitions.

Groups rotate through activities such as the stretcher relay, travois relay, and others. Points and prizes are awarded. This is a great opportunity to interact with other troops and enjoy the Scouting spirit.

Food Services:

Option—Bring Your Own: Your unit would be responsible for planning nutritious meals, bringing and storing the food for the week, and doing whatever cooking and preparation that is required.

Unimproved group camping offered. Water is provided in buffalos so please conserve. Garbage service and latrines provided. If showers are desired, units must bring their own.
