 The Bishop is the Executive Officer/Institutional Head of all the ward's Scout units.
 A Bishopric Counselor is the Chartered Organization Rep. of all the ward's Scout units.
 Some positions in the the unit can be filled by the same person, i.e. the IH or CR can also be a Committee Chair or Committee Member.
 Unit Leaders (CM, SM) cannot serve in any other position in the same unit.
 Unit Leader and Committee Member positions are often best filled by parents of boys in the Scouting Program
