- Take just one course or register for multiple courses!
- Fees include the cost of NRA materials, food and lodging (where indicated, Dorms are first come, first served) or a place to pitch your tent for multiple day courses.
- Course fees do NOT include NRA/USA Archery Membership or NRA/USA Archery certification fees, cost of firearms or ammunition.
- **ALL Instructor Candidates must attend and successfully complete the NRA Basic Shooting course in the discipline they wish to become an instructor for PRIOR to attending the Instructor level course – These will be held on Sat April 18 9am-5pm at the Cache Valley Shooting Range and/or on Wednesday April 29 9am-5pm**
- **Basic Instructor Training (BIT) is a required Pre-requisite for all NRA Instructor level courses (Rifle, Shotgun, Pistol, and Muzzle-loading Rifle). You must register for and complete BIT before you attend an instructor course in any discipline. BIT is not required for RSO certification or Archery.**
- **THESE COURSES ARE FOR BSA VOLUNTEERS ONLY.** You must be a registered BSA volunteer, have completed BSA youth Protection, and be willing to volunteer your time with BSA Shooting events and activities to be eligible to participate. (verification documents will be required. i.e. BSA registration id card and youth protection certificate)
