

# Triple-S Equipment Checklist

## Required Items to Bring with You

- Your personal Medical Release Form
- Official Scout Uniform (Field Uniform) for your scouting position. (Note: A Complete Uniform includes the official shirt, pants or shorts, socks, neckerchief and a belt.)
- Scout Activity Uniform(s). (Note: An activity uniform includes a Scout T-shirt or knit shirt and scout pants or shorts).
- Shoes or Boots
- Scout Cap - The official BSA hat of your choice. (Note: You may also choose to not wear a hat)
- Windbreaker or Jacket
- Rain Gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Extra Underwear
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Ground pad, air mattress, or cot (Note: If you are sleeping in the bunkhouses, there are mattresses included. If you are sleeping in a tent, make arrangements to bring your own air mattress or cot.)
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Flashlight or Headlamp with spare batteries
- Pocketknife or multiple tool-type knife (no fixed-blade knives)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and Washcloths
- Pens, Pencils and Notebook (Note: A binder of handouts and note paper will be provided.)
- Canteen or Water Bottle
- Handbook(s) for your scouting program
- Backpack for carrying your gear to and from the learning area
- Book of Camp Songs/Skits
